

WHY REVERSE TRANFER IS IMPORTANT

A Georgetown University study through the Lumina Foundation showed that 59 percent of jobs in North Carolina will require some form of post-secondary education or training by 2018. It also showed that NC ranks only 27th among the states in the number of adults with an education beyond high school.
