- Minimum MAT/GRE score at 30th percentile
- MAT/GRE may be waived with 10 years of leadership experience
- Application due: March 15th

* Special admissions consideration will be given to non-traditional leaders who have an advanced degree from an accredited institution and an established record of highly effective leadership and contributions to the education sector. 
